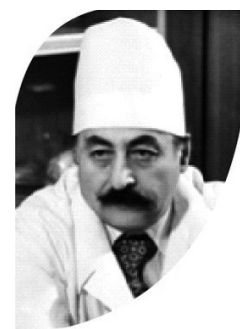
International Meeting «ILIZAROV READINGS»

The abstract should state objectives, describe material and methods used, results and discussion, conclusions. Abstracts will be published as a supplement to the *Ilizarov Journal of clinical and experimental orthopaedics (Geniy Ortopedii)* free of charge

- E-posters should be prepared in a standard format. The total file size should not exceed 10 Mb and 10 slides.
- Each poster presentation must have a title including the title of the paper, author(s), affiliation(s), city and country; then Introduction, Material and Methods, Discussion, Conclusions and the most important references (not more than 10).
